ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS (A-Z)

Clay Workshop/Open Studio: Students will make things with clay. They can also bring their own canvas, any size, to make their own painting any way they want.

Destination Imagination: Destination Imagination, part of the world's largest creative problem solving organization, is an extracurricular program that fosters creativity, team based problem solving and life skills for students. Students work together to solve open ended challenges, which include artistic, scientific, engineering and/or technical elements. **Students are required to make a payment of \$45.00 in order to participate for the full quarter. Enrolled students will not pay the \$25 after-school fee. Maximum students allowed is 35. First come, first serve.**

Harry Potter Club 9¾: Ever since J.K Rowling published her first book of the Harry Potter series, people worldwide have been captivated by the stories, the characters and the magic surrounding Hogwarts. Reading the Harry Potter series is always a special experience, but it is even more magical when shared with friends. The Harry Potter 9 ¾ Club is a group that comes together to share their love of Rowling's beloved novels, to enhance literacy, to promote creativity through arts and crafts, and to be a part of a community of creative thinkers. Albus Dumbledore once told Harry, **"It is our choices, Harry, that show what we truly are, far more than our abilities."** So make the choice to join the Harry Potter 9 ¾ Club!

Lego Robotics: Students will learn the critical skills they need to meet the challenges of a future in which innovation, originality and the ability to work with others hold the key to a successful career. Students will be picked up at 1:15 p.m. and brought back to school at 2:30 p.m. Panama STEM facilities are located in City of Knowledge. They will have an adult with them walking to and walking back to school. **Students are required to make a payment of \$80.00 in order to participate for the full quarter. Enrolled students will not pay the \$25 after-school fee.**

Painting Workshop: This workshop will be a recreational, cultural and intellectual learning experience for our students. Student will develop creativity and love for painting. **Students will be required to make a payment of \$120.00 in order to participate for the full quarter. This payment include materials needed. Enrolled students will not pay the \$25 after-school fee**

Racquetball: Raquetball is a sport played with a hollow rubber ball in an indoor or outdoor court. Coach Ricaurte Miranda is offering classes once a week. Some benefits of this sports are strengthening bones and muscles, improving balance, coordination and flexibility. The classes will be held at the KIWANIS Gym. **Students will be required to make a payment of \$45.00 in order to participate for the full quarter. Enrolled students will not pay the \$25 after-school fee.**

Swim Team: Students will be joining BA's swim team. Students that enroll in this activity must show commitment to stay and follow at all times the coaches' instructions. Students will practice twice a week and participate in invitational meets as they are presented. **Students who wish to join the swim team must be able to swim 25 meters unassisted.**
