Kindergarten- Grade 12 Hybrid Learners

- May return to school to four days-a-week:

Preschool- Grade 5

Distance Learning Model

- ▶ Preschool programs will offer developmentally- appropriate at-home activities
- ▶ Kindergarten through grade 5 will be through Virtual Virginia (VVA).
 - ▶ FCPS will fund the program.
 - ▶ Commitment will be for entire semester.
 - ▶ All instruction comes from VVA teachers.

Face-to-Face Learning Model

- ▶ Students attend school five days -a-week.
- ▶ Asynchronous instruction will not be provided.

Distance Learning Model

- ▶ Students receive synchronous instruction following their class schedule during normal school hours (TBD).
