As SchoolStatus, Smore's parent company, discovered in recent family and educator surveys, 47% of parents want consistent weekly information from schools, while only 15% of educators report sending information on a weekly basis. Administrative Benefits

From a communications director's perspective, Smore for Teams also offers valuable oversight capabilities. "What I really love is that at any point in time I can jump into the platform and see what has been sent, what is being sent, and what's scheduled," shared Ms. Power. "It cuts out the gray area. It cuts out the questions. You know exactly what's being said."


This visibility has led to improved strategic communication planning, "Through the time that I've been with our district, it's been a really fun learning opportunity for me to be able to help teach our district leaders about the critical times for sending communication...helping them understand how we all are on the same team and we all impact each other on those open rates." Using this data, Power is able to recommend the best times to send communications so families aren't overwhelmed, leading to stronger school-home engagement and higher open rates for their newsletters.

For other districts, Power offers encouraging words, "I think it is sometimes daunting to think about adding another tool or onboarding another platform into your district. Whether it be a large district or a small district, whether you have an IT team to help

you bring it on or you don't, it can be scary and nerve-wracking."

To mitigate this, she


emphasizes the value of the support available. "The team at Smore, they're here to help... don't ever hesitate to ask a question because there's somebody here who has the answer."
